Dear PAACS Family,

By the end of 2021, we expect to graduate an additional 19 surgeons for Africa. By 2022, PAACS plans to add new General Surgery programs in Burundi, Madagascar and a second General Surgery training program in Malawi. Additionally, we hope to open specialty training programs in the near future in Surgical Endoscopy, Plastic Surgery, Anesthesia, and Obstetrics and Gynecology. This is all due to PRAYER.

Please continue to pray for PAACS by using this prayer guide. I ask that you pray daily for the needs of PAACS, our residents, faculty, graduates and others. This guide will serve as a useful tool as you beseech God to bless the lives of these individuals. I am certain that God will use these men and women to continue to change the surgical and spiritual landscape of the African continent for His glory because of your faithful prayers. The Practice of Biblical Prayer and Fasting

Sometimes Christians ask, "Why should I practice fasting?" Although there is no place where the New Testament commands believers to fast, there are very good examples of them entering into periods of fasting and prayer. We know that Jesus fasted on occasion, and He assumes His followers would also (Matt. 6:16-18). He rebukes those who fast with erroneous motives. The book of Acts records times of corporate



fasting (Acts 13:2; 14:23). The context of these occasions is that of worshipping and making major decisions, though these are not the only purposes for us to incorporate fasting into our spiritual disciplines.

The primary purpose of fasting is not to twist God's arm into granting what you want. Rather, it is a focused time when a believer deprives herself/himself of food or some other pleasure for the purpose of deepening their relationship with God. Below are several benefits from Scripture that support a believer entering into a designated time of fasting and prayer.

Fasting aligns our hearts with God...

- by demonstrating our HUMILITY before Him (Ezra 8:21; Psalm 69:10)
- through our REPENTENCE and CONFESSION of sin (1 Samuel 7:6; 1 Kings 21:27)
- by acknowledging our sole DEPENDENCE on Him (Deuteronomy 8:2-3; Matthew 4:1-4)
- by discerning His WILL and DIRECTION in our lives (Judges 20:26-28; Acts 13:1-3, 14:23)
- by increasing our appetite to PRAY (Mark 1:35)
- by increasing our appetite for Him and His WORD (Matthew 4:1-4; John 4:31-35; 6:33-35; 1 Peter 2:2)

Again, fasting should never be viewed as a way in which we attempt to coerce God (as if we could) to grant us certain things. Rather, fasting is an act of faith and worship. Faith that God hears our prayers. Faith in the reality that as I quiet the distractions in my life, the voice of God is heard more clearly. Faith that God will act in response to my prayers according to His wisdom. And worship, knowing His answer will always reflect the good and best thing for me, though the answer may not be what I prayed for.

It is my prayer that as we enter into another year of ministry to the medically needy, that we would join our hearts and voices together in times of fasting and prayer as we seek to be the aroma of Christ to the many that God has placed in our sphere of influence. We will keep you informed of specific times that we can worship together via prayer and fasting. May God grant you sweet times of fellowship with Him as you seek His will in every area of your life.

ABOUT PAACS

The Pan-African Academy of Christian Surgeons (PAACS) is a rural-based surgical training program in African Christian Hospitals, directed by experienced, board-certified surgeons. It is a Christ-centered five-year residency that:

- Trains and disciples young African physicians as surgeons and followers of Jesus Christ;
- Provides close supervision with increasing responsibility;
- Promotes life-long learning and self-assessment.

PAACS began as a unique response to the great need for surgical care in Africa. According to the World Health Organization, there should be one surgeon for a population of 20,000. Many places in Africa only have one surgeon for 250,000 people. In other places, it is worse – only one surgeon for 2.5 million people, resulting in needless death and permanent disability. Many Africans, especially in rural and under-resourced areas, find themselves unable to find surgical care or having to travel long distances, sometimes for days, to get the care they need. This can lead to the worsening of their medical condition and the increasing likelihood of serious complications and potential death.

PAACS was created to help meet this need. PAACS trains African physicians to become surgeons to care for Africa's sick and those without access to surgery. PAACS also disciples these surgeons to provide spiritual hope to their patients in the name of Jesus Christ. At this time, PAACS is the only program in Africa that combines accredited surgical training with a spiritual curriculum. This model provides a permanent and sustainable solution to the critical surgical need, rather than a temporary response.

PAACS partners with established mission and faith-based hospitals to provide training in surgery to African physicians. PAACS recruits Christian doctors who have been called to make a commitment to serve God and those in greatest need in the underserved areas of Africa. PAACS residents receive intensive training from board certified surgeons who serve as short and long-term faculty. Without PAACS, most of these residents would not be able to afford this type of training. PAACS also provides a formal spiritual curriculum and theological training, teaching residents to minister and spread the good news of Jesus to their patients. This equips them to become medical, community, and spiritual leaders. Those who benefit the most are the people of Africa who otherwise might not have access to quality surgical care and the opportunity to know the truth of Jesus Christ.
