Partnering Together in Prayer

Philippians 1:3-11

Prayer is not just unique to Christianity. Many religions have a practice of offering prayer. What is unique for Christians is that God hears and answers. He prizes their partnership in the gospel. (v. 5, 7)

What a joy it is to know that we are not in this alone. There is great encouragement from knowing we have teammates. We should prize the opportunity to pray together.

He is completely confident in God’s ability to answer. (v. 6)

We can pray with the certainty of knowing that God will answer. Yes, there are times God’s answer is “no” or something different. But we can be confident it is for our best!

He prays for their love to abound. (v. 9)

When the love of Christ abounds, it becomes a sanctifying process in our lives.

He prays with an eye towards the future. (v. 10)

Sometimes the pressure of the moment blurs our vision. We can be sure of Christ’s return to usher in the eternal kingdom. He holds the past, present, and future.

He prays his requests will bring praise and glory to God. (v.11)

Paul’s prayer is not self-serving. His ultimate prayer is that God would always receive the praise and glory.

As we enter another year of partnership around the God-given ministry of PAACS, let’s ask God to unite hearts in one continual attitude of prayer.

About PAACS

The Pan-African Academy of Christian Surgeons (PAACS) is a rural-based training program for surgeons, anesthesiologists, and obstetrician/gynecologists in African Christian Hospitals, directed by experienced, board-certified doctors. It is a Christ-centered five-year residency that:

- Trains and disciples young African physicians as surgeons, anesthesiologists, and obstetrician/gynecologists and followers of Jesus Christ;
- Provides close supervision with increasing responsibility;
- Promotes life-long learning and self-assessment.

PAACS began as a unique response to the great need for surgical care in Africa. According to the World Health Organization, there should be one surgeon for a population of 20,000. Many places in Africa only have one surgeon for 250,000 people. In other places, it is worse – only one surgeon for 2.5 million people, resulting in needless death and permanent disability. Many Africans, especially in rural and under-resourced areas, find themselves unable to find surgical care or having to travel long distances, sometimes for days, to get the care they need. This can lead to the worsening of their medical conditions and the increasing likelihood of serious complications and potential death.

PAACS was created to help meet this need. PAACS trains African physicians to become surgeons, anesthesiologists, and obstetrician/gynecologists to care for Africa's sick and those without access to care. PAACS also disciples these residents to provide spiritual hope to their patients in the name of Jesus Christ. At this time, PAACS is the only program in Africa that combines accredited surgical, anesthesia, and obstetric/gynecological training with a spiritual curriculum. This model provides a permanent and sustainable solution to the critical need, rather than a temporary response.

PAACS partners with established mission and faith-based hospitals to provide training in surgery, anesthesia, and obstetrics/gynecology to African physicians. PAACS recruits African Christian doctors who have been called to make a commitment to serve God and those in greatest need in the underserved areas of Africa. PAACS residents receive intensive training from board-certified surgeons and specialists who serve as short and long-term faculty. Without PAACS, many of these residents would not be able to afford this type of training. PAACS also provides a formal spiritual curriculum and theological training, teaching residents to minister and spread the good news of Jesus to their patients. This equips them to become medical, community, and spiritual leaders. Those who benefit the most are the people of Africa who otherwise might not have access to quality surgical, anesthesia, and obstetric/gynecological care and the opportunity to know the truth of Jesus Christ.
